

FAQ

1. What if I don't have enough people of one division to make a team?
 - You can still have a team; you will play up to the oldest player. Ex. You have 5 middle school players, 5 High School players, and 5 college/adult players. You will play in the College/Adult division.
2. What if I have people on the roster but they do not show up on the day of the tournament?
 - You have two choices, 1. Leave them on the roster, pay for them and they can play when they get there, or 2. Mark them out on your roster before taking it to the registration page. What you owe in tournament fees will be based on the number of people on the roster.
3. There are only 20 places on the roster, can I have more than 20 on a team.
 - No. Minimum 10, Maximum 20 on a team/roster.
4. I have players that have to work so they can't play all day or can't make it to the first game, do they need to do anything special?
 - For late comers: As long as they are on the roster that was turned in before the first game and they have paid their fee and have turned in the appropriately signed waiver and have to be stopped by the registration table to receive an arm band then they can play when they get there. For early leavers, anyone can leave when they need to, but keep in mind that the arm band that they have on must remain on if they wish to return to the tournament.
5. I have a question about a rule interpretation, how do I get a clarification?

6. What fields are we playing on at Sokol?
 - We are playing on the Men's softball fields
7. What kind of tournament will we be playing?
 - This can change depending on the actual number of teams participating, but as of now, we plan on playing a double elimination tournament in each division starting at 10am. Each division will play on one field. So we say the tournament will start at 10 but your teams first game may not be until 11:00am or 12:00pm. If this changes we will let you know.
8. How will I know when my teams first game time will be?
 - After the March 23rd deadline, we will seed and place the teams participating. Someone with O2 Ministries will contact the coach or captain on their game time. If in doubt, tell your team to be ready to play at 10:00am, at the worst they are two hrs early and get to scout the other teams playing.

9. You said you will seed the tournament bracket, how is the seeding taking place?

- It will be a blind draw seed. We will put all of the teams of that division into a hat and draw one at a time, the first drawn is the Number 1 seed, the second drawn is the Number 2 seed, and so on.

10. Can I have more than one team?

- Yes, teams are filled on a first come first serve basis, based on receiving the registration form and deposit. Spaces are limited. We would like to have as many churches and organizations represented as possible but one church having a team in the middle school division, one in the High School division, and one in the College/Adult division.
